Professor Lau served as Editor-in-Chief of the APLAR Journal of Rheumatology/International Journal of Rheumatic Diseases from 2004–2012. Widely published, his major research interests include systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) and rheumatoid arthritis (RA), focusing on immunogenetics, T and B cell function and apoptosis in these conditions.
